CENTURION SOCIAL POOL LEAGUE CONSTITUTION

1 Titel

The league will be known as CENTURION SOSIALE POOLLIGA, with the abbreviation C.S.P.L. Henceforth referred to as the League.

2 Definitions

2.1 Membership Fees

Membership fees is payable by the team captains that registered a team at a participating club of the League. Team captains is responsible to pay all monies due before the 1st of May of each financial year.

2.2 Players

A player is any person that participated in one or more games during the year.

2.3 Club

Any bar or pool club within the Municipality of Centurion that conforms to the minimum requirements of the League.
Requirements: Minimum 1 team for every 2 pool tables with a maximum of 2 teams for every 2 pool tables.

2.4 Representatives

Team captains are the appointed representatives of the clubs with whom they are registered.

2.5 Committee

Committee consists of the appointed members.

2.6 Management committee

The management committee consists of a chairperson, treasurer, match co-ordinator, secretary and an additional member.

2.7 Meetings

2.7.1 Annual General Meeting

The annual general meeting must be held within the first 2 months of the financial year. Each player that played in the prior year can attend the meeting. New or prospective member can attend the meeting as guests.

2.7.2 Committee Meetings

The committee will get together as is necessary through the course of the year.

2.8 Voting Rights

All permanent players that played the previous year, club owners and committee member has voting rights at the Annual General Meeting. Each player, owner, committee member has one vote. The chairperson of the league has the deciding vote. Guests have no voting rights.

2.9 Bylaws to the League

The management committee will control this function.

2.10 Special Meetings

A Special meeting can be requested by the management committee or at the request of two thirds of the participating clubs.

2.11 Korum

2.11.1 Annual General Meeting

All players, captains, club owners and at least two thirds of the management committee that is present at the time of the Annual General Meeting.

2.11.2 Management Committee Meetings

Two thirds of the management committee must be present.

2.12 Financial Year

The Financial Year is from the 1st of January to the 31st of December.

3 Head office

The head office will be the residence of the chairperson or club as determined by the management committee.

4 Purpose

The purpose of the social league to accommodate players and to advance the interest of pool.

5 Rights and duties of the management committee

5.1 To adjust, accept and enforce the rules of the League.

5.2 Accept or deny registration per Korum by the management committee.

5.3 To administer the League.

5.4 Appointment or disbandment of disciplinary committees. Disciplinary committees will consist of three members.

5.5 Open and manage a bank account in the name of the League. The chairperson and two management committee members must have signing powers.

5.6 Management of a trophy register.

5.7 Management of club and player membership.

5.8 Creating a cashflow statement and making it available at the Annual General Meeting.

5.9 To create and maintain an asset register.

5.10 To create and maintain the bylaws to the League.

5.11 To setup a budget.

5.12 To reimburse expenses incurred by the management committee according to the budget.

5.13 Appointing players to attend referee courses.

5.14 The chairperson or appointed representative will preside on all meetings.

5.15 Club owners and/or captains will communicate with the secretary regarding any problems with players or clubs.

6 Chairperson

The chairperson or representative will preside over all meetings. The chairperson and treasurer will manage all financial aspects of the League and they will have joint signing powers to make any withdrawals from the bank account or other investments.

The chairperson will attend to the needs and requirements of the League with the aid of the management committee. He or she will see to it that all actions will be in line with the needs of the clubs and players according to the budget.

The chairperson can make proposals and discuss subjects that is in the interest of the League. He or she can ban discussions on any subjects that is not in the interest of the League, its players or club owners at meetings.

7 Treasurer

The treasurer is responsible for depositing monies on behalf of the League as well as generating the Financial Statements of the League.

8 Match Coordinator

The Match coordinator oversees all matches, and scheduling thereof, that is played in the League. He or she will determine the provisions and will make this available to the chairperson.

The match-coordinator will determine the schedule of the matches to be played and will make this available to the clubs and team captains.

He or she will make sure that the rules of S.A pool is practiced at all matches and will coordinate any discussions regarding the rules with all players.

9 Secretary

The secretary will take minutes at all meetings and will make this available to the chairperson. He or she will attend to all administrative duties as required by the chairperson.

10 Committee members

Committee members will serve as the link between the League and clubs or players.

11 Tenure

Management committee members will serve for two years. A new management committee must be appointed at the annual general meeting of the third year.

12 Dress code

Players must be dressed neatly at all matches.

13 Regulations

Regulations are binding on all members if it is decided on by the management committee at the annual general meeting and it is accepted by a majority vote.

14 Amendments

Amendments to the constitution can only be done at the annual general meeting with a thirty-day notice period to be provided to all members.

15 Disbanding

The league can only be disbanded with a two third majority vote at a special meeting and one hundred percent (100%) of all participating clubowners agree to it.
